What is personification?

As you are completing the assignments, please understand the following:

- 1. Once a student clicks "Submit", it cannot be re-opened.
- 2. The assignments from the "Get Ready" will automatically save, but the <u>written response</u> items during the read need to be saved in each box that they type in.
 - o For example, if a student completes a response for the first annotation, they need to hit SAVE.
- 3. If a student needs to exit and did not complete the activity, they can hit <u>pause/resume</u> to come back to an assignment they have already started without losing any progress. However, once they hit save or submit, they cannot go back to the assignment for corrections or access.
- 4. Students need to click "Submit" for all online assessments for them to be scored.

Reading strategies to implement whenever possible:

- Identify who or what the passage is about.
- Underline important information about people, places, dates and events.
- Make sure to look closely at all of the text and graphic features (graphs, headings, pictures, captions, etc.)
- If a word is underlined, box it in and try to figure out what it means by using context
- Identify the characters and circle their names.
- Identify the setting (place and time) and circle it.
- Identify the problems in the story and circle them.
 - Write a letter "P" when you find them.
- Identify the solutions in the story and circle them.
 - Write a letter "S" when you find them.
- Pay close attention to all of the characters... their actions, feelings and changes they go through.
- If a word is underlined, box it in and try to figure out what it means.


